Grading Scale

Emmanuel Christian Academy has a standard grade scale that is used by all teachers. Daily work and tests count for 80% of the semester grade and the semester exam counts for 20% of the semester grade. Using a regular day schedule, all courses meet daily in 42 minute class periods. Grade point average is computed on a 4.0 scale for most courses and includes all grades earned. Rank in class is determined by the grade point average of all students in a particular class of graduation. Class rank and grade point average are updated each semester.
